Tim has studied Contemporary Maori Design. He has studied Whakairo (carving) and developed his culture through understanding the meaning of design. Tim has completed commissioned works using spray paint and has also done numerous bone carvings. Other mediums Tim loves working with are chalk, acrylic and pastels.

Class - Maori Arts - Graphics Materials cost - approx \$15.00 payable to tutor Bring - pencils and drawing paper Course length - 2 days

Class description -Develop and paint design using Maori symbols and concepts. Develop and paint designs for bone carving.

2 Les Riddell - Jewellery Manufacture

Les is a classically trained Master Goldsmith from Northern Canada. He has worked from his workshop Object Of Art in Central Otago for 13yr and runs workshops and classes from his studio in Old Cromwell Town

Class - Jewellery Manufacture
