#### **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. All artwork must be original and the sole work of the artist.
- 2. Artists must be 16 years of age or older.
- 3. Artwork must not have been previously exhibited in a COAS exhibition.
- 4. Artwork that has won an award in a previous exhibition will not be eligible for a COAS award.
- 5. Giclée, photography and AI art are excluded.
- 6. Paintings must be mounted ready for hanging and not have any protruding screws.
- 7. A swing tag must be attached to each artwork stating
  - Artist's name
- Title of the work
- Medium
- Price
- 8. Sculptures and ceramics must have a plinth provided.
- 9. Unframed bin folder work must be laid on stiff board and be covered with cellophane. A label must be attached to the back stating
  - Artist's name
- Title of the work
- Medium
