#### 1. JEWELLERY

Tutor: Les Riddell Venue: Objects of Art

Date: Monday 12 March - Tuesday 13 March (2 days)
Cost: \$120 plus materials \$35-\$50 (Costs may vary depending on choice of precious metals)

Make your own piece of jewellery. Explore gravity and centrifugal casting in precious metals. Be prepared to carve wax, use fire and get dirty. Old silver jewellery may be melted down to use.

### 2. PLEIN AIR PAINTING

Date: Saturday 10 March

Cost: \$65

Nigel will create a plein air painting from the banks of the lake. Learn more about your own expressive techniques and methods. Share the fun experience of painting outdoors with other artists. Bring your own materials.

# 3. WRITING FROM THE EDGE OF NOT-KNOWING

## 6. PRINTMAKING: NON-TOXIC DRYPOINT ETCHING

Cost: \$100 (maximum 4 people) includes materials,

tools and notes.

Learn non-toxic Drypoint etching techniques on acrylic to produce an Intaglio print from your own design. We will extend this technique by adding materials and colour. Chine Colle, Collagraph & Mono-print techniques will be demonstrated to try for yourself. This workshop is designed for students with none to intermediate printmaking skills. Bring along an A5 design, photograph or drawing to work with (and an apron).

#### 7. WATERCOLOUR FUSION
