Exhibition Name:	"OnBoard" - Recycled Snowboard Exhibition			
Exhibition Concept:	To offer up an opportunity for exhibiting works created by artists and/or snowboarders, who have a specific connection to the sport. The exhibition is a low-profile chance for artists brought together by a sport they love, to create a piece of work reflecting their individual talents & skills, while highlighting their love for the snow discipline. The exhibition is organised free of payment and as 'Not For Profit'; while proceeds will be dispensed through two local charities connected to the Snow culture and worthy of receipt of community generated funds.

- Art works must be left on exhibition for the entirety of the Exhibition and artists ready to pick-up throughout Tuesday June 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Insurance of the individual artworks whilst in the Gallery, storage or in transit is at the full responsibility of the Artist. All care will be taken not to damage any art piece/s, however responsibility **cannot** be taken for the action of visitors to the Gallery over the exhibition period (including the Opening Night). While all care will be taken, the Gallery and Coordinators will accept no responsibility for loss or damage of artworks.
- It is encouraged that ALL artists be in attendance for the Opening Night, as there will be a round of prizes for exhibited artworks; ranging from Sponsors Prize, Beneficiary Prizes and Gallery Manager Prize. This will also be a great opportunity to socialise with other contributing artists.
- On the Opening Night, there will be space set aside for the two beneficiary organisations to present details of their products and programs. There will also be some food & beverage options supplied, however remembering, this is an 'Art Exhibition'.

# Artist Scope: Exhibition pieces can use all the normal artistic license open to creating a piece of art. The directive is for a connection to snow and more specifically (although not exclusively) to snowboarding, as a sport. Hence, the canvas for artists for this exhibition, will be old, broken or warrantied snowboards. The exhibition will have a variety of viewers, both from an artistic background, as well as many members of the general public and families. Therefore, is it required that all artistic pieces produced, be for 'general consumption'. Both ourselves as coordinators and Andie as the Gallery Manager, reserve the right to refuse exhibit of any piece we feel would breach a public 'duty of care'. In addition to this, a number of the *canvas's* will be supplied by high-profile snowboard brands. This is generous of them. So, we ask in reply to this, that no presentation, highlighting or prominence is directed towards the brand who may have supplied that particular *canvas*.

Artist Profile Concept: An Artist Entry Fee of \$40 will be charged to exhibit a piece or pieces by any individual. We are encouraging the artists (should they chose) to affiliate themselves with a local business as a sponsor. In response to acquiring this \$40 Entry Fee (paid by the Sponsor Business), the artist can offer the business the opportunity to be presented on a Description Card alongside their piece, for the entirety of the Exhibition. On the card will be the name of the artist, as well as the name of the piece, a description of the type of construction or creation, and finally a small name & logo placement for their chosen Sponsor Business. Artists can choose to pay their own Entry Fee.

Additionally, we are asking any artists if they would be interested in selling their piece as a compulsory donation to the Beneficiaries. This is certainly not a requirement of exhibiting, more so a simple opportunity or act that would assist greatly with the overall financial amount achieved for the beneficiary organisations. If you chose this option, this will be marked on the description card beside your art piece, with a price, and visitors can record a purchase interest with any of the Coordinators or Gallery Manager.

NOTE: There will be a commission taken by the Gallery (reduced to 10% for this exhibition), which covers their 'Administration Costs". Outside of this, ALL other funds generated will be passed directly to the beneficiaries.
