Guest Artist: Sarah Freiburger, Dunedin

Sarah grew up in Southern Germany where she spent the first twenty years of her life. Painting has always been important to her. She learnt her skills by experimenting, observing and painting alongside passionate painters. She moved to New Zealand at the end of 2011 and settled in Dunedin. She mainly paints New Zealand landscapes with a touch of realism. Her absolute favorites are forest scenes. She primarily works with acrylic paint on a smooth, hard surface. Her acrylic works mainly focus on the play of light in nature. In 2014 she exhibited in Dunedin's former Mint Gallery where she had four successful solo shows. She regularly exhibits works at the Otago Art Society and Moray Gallery in Dunedin.

Presentation:

1. All exhibits must be professionally presented ready for exhibition (with hangings for paintings/ photography)

If paintings don't have appropriately strung backs for hanging they may not be accepted.

- 2. All exhibits must have the name of the artist on the back with address, title, medium and catalogue price.
- 3. All work must be the sole work of the Artist.
- 4. Any Artwork entered may be photographed or put on social media for the purpose of promoting the exhibition

Commission:

We sell on a 15% commission and exhibitors are asked to include that in their sale price. All exhibits must be for sale.

Freight:

Exhibitors are asked to pay all freight costs to and from the exhibition. Packaging is to be labelled with your name and address which will be retained for repackaging.

Delivery:

Quilts/Wall Hangings (please note hanging sleeves are required) are to be posted or hand delivered by 7 May to Clutha District Council Service Centre Office, 1 Suffolk Street, Tapanui. Insurance in transit and during the exhibition is the responsibility of the artist.

Selection:

The Exhibition Committee's decision on acceptance or rejection will be final. Accepted work can not be removed before the end of the exhibition being Tuesday 14th May 2024, 4.00 pm.
